ACTIONS TO BE CARRIED OUT	<u>WHO MUST DO IT</u> <i>(write it in)</i>	WHEN
<p>BEFORE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss the likely hazards or dangers- HURRICANE, FLOOD, FIRE, EARTHQUAKE /TSUNAMI) that can affect your family and your home. • Ask yourself, is your home really safe to weather a storm or an emergency? • Listen to your Radio and Television, especially on Holidays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays. • When NEMO declares Phase 1- or an ALERT, One Red Flag put your Family Plan into action, immediately • Inform family members what is happening, where to go, when to come home and so on.

<p><u>IMPORTANT THINGS TO DO</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchase non-perishable food and water - 1 gallon per person per day (keep 1 week supply) • Put together your Family Emergency Kit: Pack blanket, rain clothing, change of clothing, games to play and books to read. Include in your medical bag/first aid kit; Bandages, hydrogen peroxide, water purification tablet, toilet paper, pampers, Clorox, plastic bags, sanitary napkins, baby wipes, anti itch - cream, personal medicine etc. • Secure important documents – Passport, house papers, insurance documents, school certificates in plastic bag. Take pictures of important and valuable items. • Fuel up vehicle, Put away or pack valuable household items including furniture • Remove loose objects around the yard, the car, lawnmower, fuel containers, zinc, lumber etc. • Trim the trees and throw away the pieces, Secure windows and doors- put up shutters • Move or secure pets with food and water • Get your lanterns, radio and flashlight, buy extra batteries. DO NOT USE CANDLES! 		
<p><u>IF EVACUATING</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MOVE EARLY, if going by bus tell the family, know your route & name - location of shelter • Plug out all electrical items- Iron, refridge, microwave, TV, Stereo. • Turn off all main water valves and electrical main switch box 		
<p>AFTER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Return home if it is safer than where you are if you are safe. Listen to NEMO Advisories. • DO NOT MOVE around IF YOUR AREA WAS AFFECTED. • When approaching your home, be careful! • Check the safety (structure and toilet system) of your home, be aware of pests and snakes • Do not turn on main valves until BEL and BWS say so, • Do not drink water straight form the tap, boil or purify it first 		<p>‘All Clear’ 1 Green Flag</p>
